Our five year old granddaughter is staying with us this week so this newsletter is short, sweet and to the point.

Hibiscus are lovely in the tropics but we have equally lovely hibiscus that are hardy here. They tend to be a bit slow to break dormancy but once they get growing, they make up for lost time by putting on a terrific bloom show late summer through fall. We have Rose of Sharon shrubs (*Hibiscus syriacus*) and Swamp Mallow (*Hibiscus x moscheutos*) in many different colours. **The week all the hardy hibiscus are 40% off.**

A 'tried and true' late summer plant combination uses stonecrop, Russian sage, black eyed Susans and ornamental grasses. While this combination is at its best mid-July through September, it looks good late spring through summer and even provides winter interest if you don't cut it back and the birds will love you for it!
