**Japanese Knotweed**

Next Saturday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, at 11am we'll be hosting a workshop by the Columbia Shuswap Invasive Species Society on garden plants that have, or can, become invasive - ones that should not

grown at all, or grown with care to make sure they don't become invasives in our area. Please register for the workshop; it's FREE but we'd like to know how many people to expect so we can set up the appropriate number of chairs.

We have some plants in stock that were special-ordered by people who then decided not to take them - extremely aggravating to be sure - but it means we have some plants that we're willing to sell at *outrageously low prices*. They are:

**150 x Deer-resistant Gelderland hedging Cedars in 1 gal pots:** regularly 8.50 ea. for **5.50 ea.** Gelderland is fast-growing to about 15 feet x 6 feet, can be sheared, and is a cultivar of the native Western Red Cedar. Zone 6

**450 x Borealishaskap plants in 1 gal. pots:** regularly 8.25 for **4.50 ea.** This is the *BEST* variety for the home gardener, *having the largest berries and the best flavour* of all varieties presently available. (They're not popular with commercial processors because they 'bleed' when picked but that's not an issue in the home garden!) You'll need a second compatible variety as a pollinator but you only need 1 pollinator for every 5-7 plants. Zone 2

**40 x Wintergreen boxwood in 1 gal. pots:** regularly 10.75 for **7.00 ea.** Hardy to Cdn. Zn 5, this is a good evergreen hedging plant growing 2-4 feet high x 3-5 feet wide but can be sheared to keep it smaller.
