ingenious product and so simple to use. Hung between the hook and the hook of the basket, the Water Bungee is pulled down by the weight of the water-laden soil to expose a green inside layer. As the pot dries out and becomes lighter, less and less of the green is seen until it

disappears altogether showing you, even from a distance, that the pot needs to be watered! No more over or under watering your hanging baskets. (By the way, it's better to *underwater*, rather than overwater, plants. Over-watering causes root rot and quickly causes plant death. Under-watering, however, is usually a condition the plant can recover from - unless it goes on for too long.)

Another new product we have in stock is a cute life-like bird that sings when the soil of the plant it's stuck into dries out.



I'm keeping the newsletter 'short and sweet' this time. Hopefully things will have slowed to a more reasonable pace in a week or two but right now it's very busy and I just don't have time to put together a tip-filled newsletter. But I do want you to know about our features this week because they're good ones. This will probably be the last week we have Seed Geraniums in stock because they're now priced to clear.
