Plant of the Week: Populus

tremuloides



Trembling Aspen

You may be surprised that this is our feature plant this week because it is, after all, not one of my favourites. It has some pretty significant liabilities but even so, it remains a popular fast-growing tree. We have been working on a HUGE landscape project in Eagle Bay where we have used 98% NATIVE plants or their cultivated varieties. I ordered in these beautiful big aspens (singles and clumps) for the project but then didn't use them, so we're putting them on sale this week at **50% off.**

So, provided that you:

1. have a large property where this tree(which grows from 15-20m high with a spread of 8-10m) can grow unhindered,
2. don't plant this tree near sewers, septic systems, drains or sidewalks where it's roots will become invasive,
3. need a hardy (Zone 1), fast-growing native plant with fantastic yellow fall colour

this tree is for you. These are LARGE trees now so be sure to bring a truck when you come shopping!
