Foxtail lilies (Eremurus), also sometimes called Desert Candles, provide a stunning focal point in the early summer garden. They do best in full sun and must have good drainage so it is recommended that the octopus-like tubers be planted with a layer of sand or gravel below them. They're hardy in Zones 6 through 9 and in Zone 5 with extra winter protection. They are deer resistant, drought tolerant and make excellent cut flowers. **15% off this week**
